Summary: (machine translated) Dry canyon, with a lot of slope and long. In summer it can be very hard if we do not get up early. The approach, if we can do it with two cars, will be much more bearable, otherwise it is two long hours that make us reconsider this canyon.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) In the first part no, in the second part they are possible but there is a lot of undergrowth.		
Access: (machine translated) To get to Guadalest take the CV-70 in Benidorm or Alcoy. Racó Figuera and Font Major Banks We will take the detour to the reservoir and go down to the dam, cross it and at the first sharp left turn we cross the Font Major ravine. Just before the next sharp left turn (Bco Raco Figuera) we have room to park. With the access car we will continue along this road towards the tail of the reservoir, we will arrive at a crossroads where it marks "presa Guadalest 3.8", here we will take the small road that goes to the right, known as "Cami de Castells", we will try to climb with the car on this track to the upper pass. In the pass we will find a fork with three tracks, we will go to the right PR CV 150 / Font dels Teixos. Along this track about 2.6kms to a small pass with a hut on the right and a half lost track on the right. Here we park.		
Approach: (machine translated) Access Racó Figuera and Font Major From the upper parking we will take the track almost lost and we will go down towards the dry riverbed between undergrowth and skills (about 600m up to a maple tree). From the lower one we should take the Cañada Real that goes up towards the head of the Font Major and when arriving at the top turn left to look for the head.		
Tour: (machine translated) The first part of the route was more lively, with vertical rappels, consecutive, with no rest and a lot of abseiling. The second part is more open and less vertical		
Return: (machine translated) We will continue until we find the fountain and a pipe to carry water, we will follow it to a track that we will try to follow to the road, if not through the olive groves we will try to go down to the road.
