Summary: (machine translated) Simple canyon perfect for initiation, fun, although a little dressed but a path is glimpsed by which we can move forward.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) After the first rapell and before R10		
Access: (machine translated) We are located between Jumilla and El Pinós on the MU-15A. At the pk 13.2 after leaving on the left some almond trees and a water pond, we will find a sign already passed by the time and a track on the right by which we will get. We will circulate approximately 2kms until we leave the fields and get into the pine trees, there is a sharp right curve with an area on the left where you can park.		
Approach: (machine translated) We leave the track behind to get into a path that runs parallel to a dry riverbed, leaving our stream to the left. It will go up to the path of the Solana del Gato. We will follow the path of the Solana a few hundred meters to the riverbed.		
Tour: (machine translated) Shortly after entering we will find the first rapell with a parabol to mount a handrail. A dexterity and a couple of rappels to access the most interesting area, 3 rappels in a row with a recessed block that we can rapell or go under (if it has water it is dangerous). Another small rapell will take us to the last one, the Saltaor waterfall. Beautiful waterfall (when it has water) of 17m.		
Return: (machine translated) We will see a path on the left that will lead us in a short time to the access path and from there to the car.

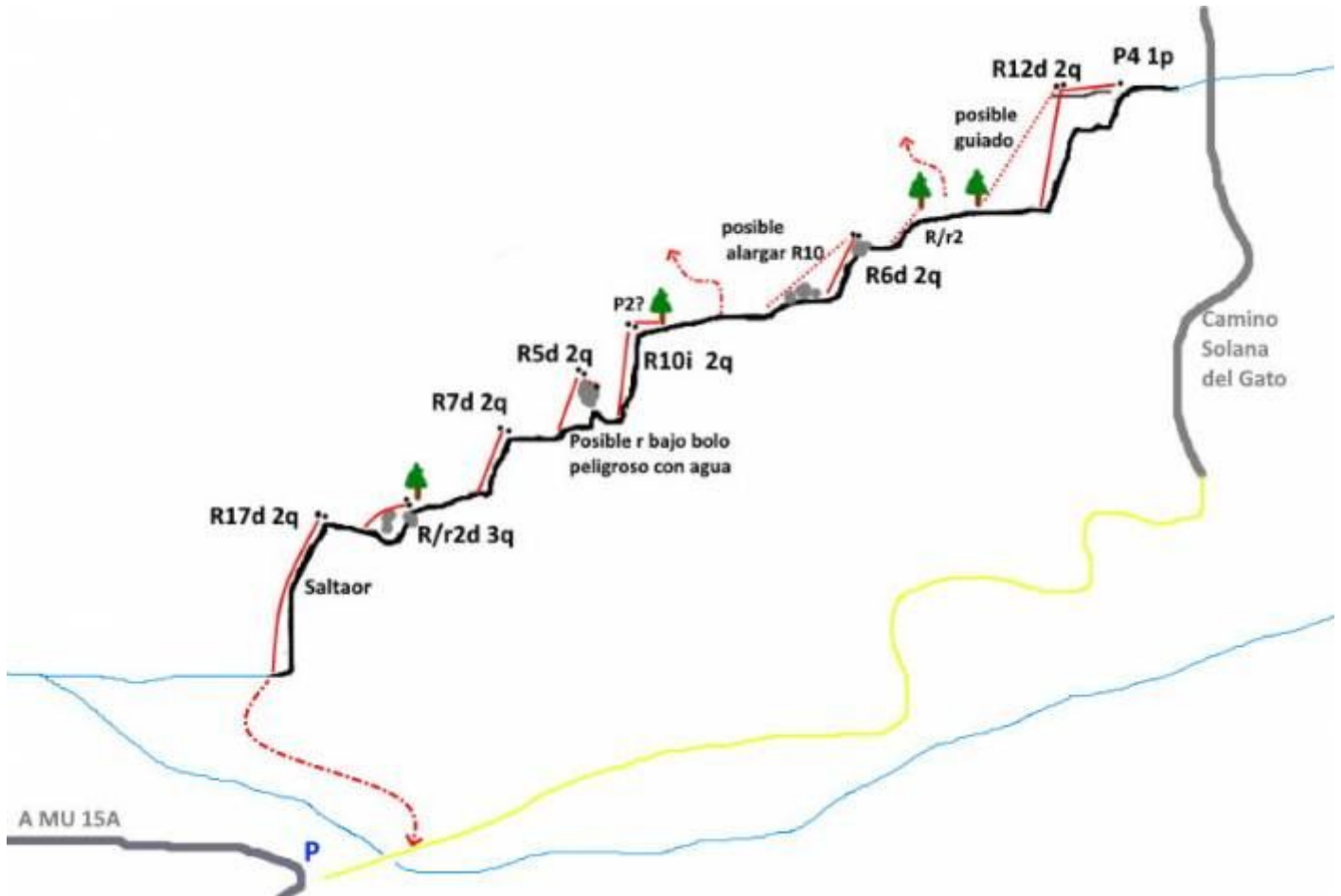
