This canyon is generally dry except after rains, when it becomes a magnificent descent. It is a vertical canyon, almost vertiginous, with great views and continuous rappels, almost without rest.

Hydrology: (machine translated)

It does not have easy escapes but it is not a gully that is going to have large water floods.

Access: (machine translated)

We are located in Ainsa (N260), we will take the A138 towards France through the Bielsa tunnel. After a few kilometers we will pass through Labuerda and at pk57 we arrive at Escalona.

Here we will take the detour to Puyarruego/Fanlo and soon to Fanlo by the HU631 until the pk 4.6 where there is a right turn with a sign to the left of the valley of Vio. We will park here.

There is the possibility of parking a second vehicle in the vicinity of Gallisué and make the approach from there having to simply descend to the riverbed.

Approach: (machine translated)

We will take the path that comes out of the same curve and that goes up to Gallisué and the Tozal of the same name. We will go up until we reach the base of the tozal, we go around it to the north and we get into a small valley with Gallisué on the other side, this is the time to leave the path and go down to the riverbed.

Tour: (machine translated)

Vertical canyon with facilities to be checked because few people pass through. Most of the rappels will be done from the natural canyon so we must be well equipped for this.
