Coming from Patras, take the first right after Zachloritika (actually straight ahead, as the main road runs to the left in the direction of Diakopto). It goes under the highway, then steeply up a concrete ramp and follows the dirt road to the parking lot (where the road forks). 4x4 not necessary!

**Approach:** (machine translated)

At the parking lot, a slope leads steeply downhill, which soon turns into a path, keeping slightly to the left. Cross a meadow area straight downhill, where you will come across tracks again until you reach the stream. From there, follow the stream to the first rapel.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

The tour carries little water and the pools are not deep, only the rappels are in the jet. The canyon narrows right at the beginning and remains continuous until the exit.

The jet fighters of the Greek army flying through the large canyon of Vouraikos are potentially frightening. If you hear the train, you should hurry to get out of one of the many tunnels. However, this was not yet in operation at the beginning of April.

Below the railroad bridge, a path leads orographic right to the tracks, which you then follow over the bridge to the left and downhill to the station.
