Upper part of the well-known Rio dell' Ambruseit. At the beginning some nice rappels then longer downclimbs/walking sections to the entry in the lower part.

### **Hydrology:**

Access: (machine translated)

Parking lot below as with the inferiore part.

Take the shuttle car and drive up towards Lovea. Park the vehicle at the parking lot for hikers at Rif Monte Sernio (approx. 500m before the parking lot for the inferiore section).

### **Approach:** (machine translated)

Follow CAI trail no. 416 (Rif Monte Sernio). This leads continuously uphill until after about 50 minutes CAI path no. 455 (Pra di Lunze) branches off to the right downhill.

Follow this downhill and you will be in the streambed for a few minutes.

## Tour: (machine translated)

Bypass 5m to the left or on the left bank using steep footpaths.

5m left (old anchor)

35m chain anchor left

Jump 3m or rappel right at the tree

Slide 4m

20m right (2 steps) 2 old and 1 new anchor in brittle rock

12m right

8m right

12m left

Then approx. 400m downclimb and stream walk

30m left

150m stream walking

Start Inferior part

Follow the inferiore part, or theoretically you can get off here and return to the parking lot
