Also known as Salto de Bocaura, it is an aesthetic descent, very excavated, fun, full of projections and badinas in which to jump. Small slides and jumps, a single rappel and a small problem, its meager flow ... We must make the descent in spring or rainy periods.

We will have to be located near Lorbés.

On the A21/N240 between Pamplona and Jaca, we will take the A137 towards Sigüés and Salvatierra. We will leave the first one behind and when we arrive to Salvatierra, in the curve that makes the road, to the left, inside the town, we will find the detour to Lorbés to the right (12km).

Along this road we will go for 7kms until almost crossing the river Gabarri, here we will find a track on the left that in north direction goes, by the orographic right of our river, until almost the headwaters. It is about 4kms of track until before the left fork.

Approach: (machine translated)

Access bcos Gabarri

We will leave following the river, north direction, towards the canyoning that is warned.

Access to Paco Chacobo, Paco Leala and Gabarri banks

We will leave to the right the waterfall of Paco Leala (generally dry) and the tributary Paco Chacobo with its cascades entobadas.

On the orographic right we follow some traces of a path that goes up over the narrows and when the ravine opens up again it is time to descend to the riverbed.
