From Corinth, drive to Pisia and turn off at the church of Agios Nektarios onto a paved road, which soon becomes a dirt track. At a clearing, you can see the path from the exit on the left and park your vehicle.

Approach: (machine translated)
Follow the slope for about 20 minutes, after which you will recognize a streambed on the left and take the first path downhill.

Tour: (machine translated)
The canyon then begins completely unexpectedly, which starts beautifully incised and remains so until the exit.

Return: (machine translated)
After the last rappel, follow the path on the left back to the vehicle in a few minutes.
