Collector's canyon or to practice in water. It has only two rappels that can be jumped. It is quite open so you can get out almost anywhere.

Hydrology: (machine translated)

For most of the route, it is quite open.

Access: (machine translated)

We are located on the N260 between Castejon de Sos and Pont de Suert.

At pk 360.8 in the village of Noales we turn off towards Castanesa going up the valley of the river Baliera. The road is gaining height and just before reaching Castanesa we see the detour (continue straight ahead) to Fonchanina.

Once in Fonchanina we will park the car of return and if we have two cars with the one of access we continue by the track towards the borda de Sarrado and we will park just before arriving to it.

Approach: (machine translated)

We will see the course of the river below, we just have to go down the meadow.

Tour: (machine translated)

Aquatic descent, with a multitude of skills, slides and jumps. We must be careful with the time we choose to do it because it usually carries a fairly high flow until well into the summer.

We have two possible rappels, the first and highest can be jumped from some ledges to the right.

Return: (machine translated)

After the narrowing and last rappel we will see a path on the left that goes up to the village.
