On the border with the Itsusi/Itxusi nature reserve is a waterfall of more than 100m split in two batches, right next to those of Espalza and Sistagorri (prohibited for being inside the reserve), it would be a great option to do after rainfall.

Since it is reviewed in other pages, we review it here, but please refrain from making the descent because of the fragility of the area in terms of endangered species such as the bearded vulture, or threatened endemic flora.
