Summary: (machine translated) Canyon with two parts, upper and lower could be done whole with combination of cars. Quite well equipped, in a beautiful area, green, with crystal clear water. Caution with the flow!		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Difficult in the upper part because it is more cannulated, the lower part is.		
Access: (machine translated) We will have to be located in Arouca, in the province of Aveiro. From here we head towards Moldes on the CM1251 and follow this road south through Bustelo until we reach Cando. In the previous curve we will be able to park and access the upper part. From Moled if we go to Pedrogao, here we can leave the access car for the lower part or return from the upper part. If from Arouca we go to Boucegedim, in the bridge over the river we would leave the car of return of the lower part.		
Approach: (machine translated) For the upper part can be accessed directly from Cando or climb from Pedrogao by the slope of Peña Amarela by a path that leads to the road. For the lower part we will go from Pedrogao by the PR8 of the mines to the access bridge.		
Tour: (machine translated) Nice descents, much more technical and interesting the upper part.		
Return: (machine translated) From the upper part we will leave by the bridge of the PR to the left towards Pedrogao. From the lower part we will arrive at Boucegedim. If we do not have the car here, there is a trail that goes up to Pedrogao.

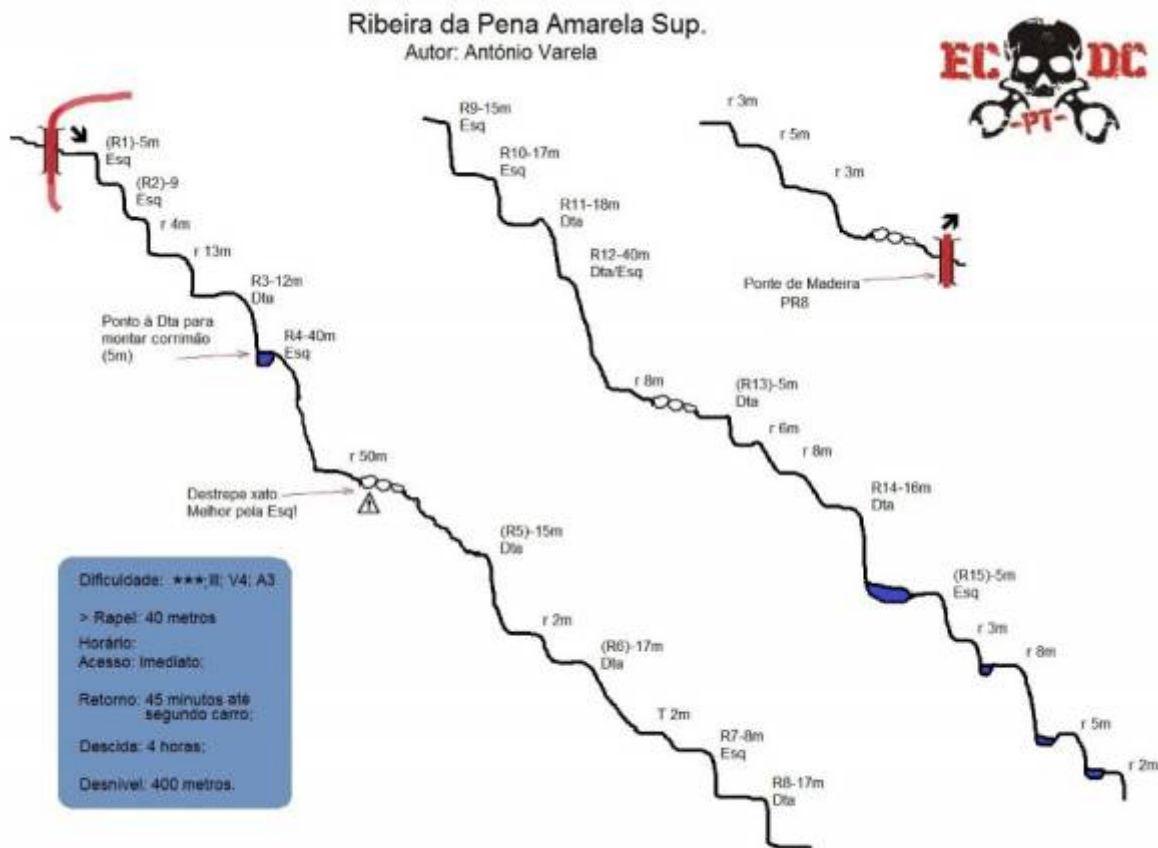
