<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) This canyon is generally dry except after rainfall, which is when it becomes interesting. With water it can be very entertaining. In addition the creek pours its waters to the ravine of Puerto de Ramos that can be easily combined.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) It is an open canyon with no problems		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From Antequera towards Valle de Abdalajís on the A343. Around pk 25 detour to the Guadalhorce reservoir. At the turnoff to the left at the Cortijo del Chopo and up to the Cortijo del Campano. We go along the track until it enters the valley and begins the hard climb. There are a couple of places where the track widens and we can park the car on the way back. We continue up, just above we turn left (in front there is a gate) and continue until we see the farmhouse at the bottom and we find another ensachamiento in which to leave the access car.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) We have to jump the fence and head towards the karst. If we see the shepherd or the owner and ask for permission, all the better. Then just follow the riverbed to the first rappel.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Canyon equipped for the rainy season, without water it loses all interest. Except for the 32m waterfall, the rest of the canyon can be climbed or descended by the side.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) We follow the stream or turn left looking for an animal trail until we reach the fence. We jump over the fence and follow the track to the car.


