Also called barranc de la Montanha de Dela, it is a very well formed ravine with a high flow in spring due to snowmelt.

**Hydrology:**

Difíciles

**Access:** (machine translated)

We will have to go to Es Bordes, near Vielha, in the Val d'Aran. From the Val d'Aran by the N230, or from France by the N125.

Between Bossost and Vielha we will find Es Bordes and here we will turn off to Era Artiga de Lin. Before reaching the end (about 6kms) there is a right turn with a farmhouse and a track that goes down to the left, cross the river on this track and soon we reach the end of the Montanha ravine.

If we have two cars, with the access car we will go up the slope until 1400m where the track approaches the stream.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

At about 1400m the track makes a sharp turn to the left, we will enter the stream here.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

More or less long rappels with access from handrails to ensure its approach. A very beautiful environment and very well formed. To take into account the great quantity of trunks that we will find in the track of access and in the ravine by the avalanches of the winter.
