Summary: (machine translated) Very beautiful canyon - technically demanding and not playful. Final waterfall (flat) with 250 m - the easiest part of the route.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Only approach when the water level is low - there are many narrow chutes in the upper part. No water catchment.		
Access: (machine translated) From Masera, take the 5533 over the Simplon Pass in the direction of Simplon and exit at Crodo. Drive through the Antigorio valley, past Baceno and Premia, and continue towards the Formazza valley. In the hamlet of Piedilago, turn right towards Cagiogno. Cross the river Toce and continue for a few hundred meters until you reach a large clearing near a very ornate house.		
Approach: (machine translated) Follow the road until you reach a wash house and then follow the signs to Alpe Bee, which can be reached via a beautiful old mule track that is almost entirely paved. At a crossroads halfway along the road, ignore the signs for Diogna and continue on the right. After reaching a first house in a meadow, continue straight on past more huts until you reach the main settlement of Bee. Follow the marked path that leads back into the forest and soon reaches the stream.		
Tour:		
Return: (machine translated) Way back: At the foot of the large waterfall, take the clearly visible path to the right, keep right at the next junction and follow the path to Cagiogno and back to the car. Nofes: The high waterfall is divided into several abseiling points, with a maximum drop height of 50 meters.
