Summary: (machine translated) Canyon with two parts separated by an intermediate zone that is not done. The upper part is more vertical and sporty although with less water. The lower part with a small cave.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) At the bottom at almost any time In the upper part possible except in the vertical		
Access: (machine translated) We must be located in Santa Cruz de la Serós, for this we will take the N240 from Pamplona to Jaca. At the height of pk 294.5 we have the detour to the Monastery of San Juan de la Peña. On this road in 4kms we will pass Santa Cruz and we will continue to enter the valley following the course of the stream. When the road makes a sharp turn to the left with a bridge over the river we will see a kind of water reservoir. This is the point to park for the upper part. About 200m down the road there is a recreational area (Cubilar de Bartolo) we can park there.		
Approach: (machine translated) For the upper part, by the path that leaves after the deposit we will go into the forest towards the upper pass. Cross the stream (return point) and continue climbing now on the orographic right. We will continue climbing up to about 1250m, just before the beech forest to get into the ravine following some cairns. The lower part is immediately accessible.		
Tour: (machine translated) The upper part is much more vertical with 6 rappels of up to 30m. The lower part is open and with the attraction of the cave (no need for a front face).		
Return: (machine translated) In the upper part we find the access road when crossing the stream. The lower part we can descend towards the village (car combination necessary) or turn left after the last rappel and climb the slope carefully towards the road or following goat trails to the parking lot.


