Summary: (machine translated) Dry canyon but very fun, it is a succession of endless rappels to the bottom. Keep in mind that the rappels can be difficult to recover the ropes and the R6 is only suitable for 2 people.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Possible in many parts of the canyon		
Access: (machine translated) Crevillente ravines situation By the A7 we go to Crevillente. If we go from Alicante we leave by the N340 we enter the town. Situation parking and access to Crevillente ravines Just at the entrance of Crevillente we take the first street on the right, a wide avenue that leads us to the north of the village, we pass by the health center leaving it on the left. We will continue straight ahead and then take some streets to the left in search of Calle Molinos. We will leave the village leaving the Hermitage of Sant Pascual on the left, we continue along the same road towards "Els Pontets" we will continue straight ahead for 1 km where we will park.		
Approach: (machine translated) Accesses Repla Pins and Colcho We will leave by the winding path that climbs to Pi de Alivi, we can also climb more smoothly by the PR CV109 following its marks. Upon reaching the pine, in the small plain, we will leave the path that climbs to the top (towards the bco Barbereta) and we will go to the right, along the path that leads us in search of the dry riverbed.		
Tour: (machine translated) We begin with a few simple rappels that could be dexterous, little by little the gully becomes narrower and we approach its most vertical rappels to reach R6, a section for 2 people maximum. From there the canyon becomes softer and the rappels become more steep.		
Return: (machine translated) At the opening of the ravine, after the last rappel, we will find a path that heads south. We will follow it to the parking area


