Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Gstaad/Saanen we drive about 11 km in southern direction to Gsteig. Approximately in the center of the village we follow the signpost to the Sanetsch cable car and turn half-left into the Innergsteigstraße/the Wallisgässli. After 1.4 km from here we come to the E-Werk on the right of the road and park our car here (1195m altitude).		
Approach: (machine translated) We cross the Saane and follow the hiking trail to the castle falls. After a good 700 meters of trail we arrive at our later exit point (1250m altitude). We continue our ascent along the stream. Several times it is crossed and allows us to assess the water flow. You can now enter at about 1400m altitude (above the 4th creek crossing, before the trail leaves the creek) - so Swiss Alps - Canyoning - Alpes Suisses. Emmanuel Belut - Laurence Boyé - Thomas Guigon, 2015 or one continues to climb un'd traverses after emerging from the forest in the direction NNO again towards the stream, where one then enters at 1450m altitude - so http://www.swestcanyon.ch/Canyons/Burgfalle/Burgfalle.htm		
Tour: (machine translated) Sequence of about 15 rappels (from the top), which continuously follow each other. At an altitude of 1250m exit to the approach path.		
Return: (machine translated) Back down the approach path and down to the car.
