Canyon of collection and local interest currently equipped with adventure, interesting to combine with Nigüelas in the afternoon and make a nice day.

**Hydrology:** (machine translated)

Possible in case of extreme need, but very wildly dressed.

From Lanjarón and Jaén street there is a paved lane that goes up to the sierra. We will follow it until we reach 3 huge water tanks and here we will park where we will not disturb the workers or the farmers.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Formerly the approach was made by the left orographic now is not possible due to conflicts with private landowners. We will follow the path of Cercerillo (without sun) on the orographic right until we reach the Montalbán irrigation ditch (with shade) which we will follow to the right towards the beginning. If this irrigation ditch carries water, it may not be a good idea to enter the ravine.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Once the ditch reaches the river in a beautiful walkways we change and enter the riverbed, perhaps going up more road there would be some more rappel. We walk 100 meters and we find the R1 of 15 meters followed by the R2 of 5 meters. After walking 100 meters we found the best rappel of the descent, the R3 12 meters dangerous with flow, followed by a delicate cliff and the R4 of 8 meters. After a tedious 500m walk will give way to two more rappels and the end of the canyon.

**Return:** (machine translated)

Practically immediately, we will arrive at a water catchment that almost dries the riverbed and is very close to our car.
