Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Leave the A 64 at Pau and take the N 134 (E 07) to Oleron-Ste-Marie. From here - continue on the N 134 - southwards up the Vallée d'Aspe. After about 50 km (from Oleron) you reach the end of the valley. About 150 m before the 180-degree hairpin bend is the parking lot de Sansanet on the righthand side. Park your car here.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot, a path leads in a westerly direction across the Eths Gaudachs. After the bridge, take the path to the right (in a northerly direction) and enter at the beginning of the narrows.		
Tour: (machine translated) Aquatic descent, short and entertaining.		
Return: (machine translated) After the short canyon opens again and flows in from the left before the Eths Caurets (also accessible canyon), you go up on the left without a trail for about 20 meters in altitude until you meet the extension of the approach trail. On this left (in southern direction) back to the car.

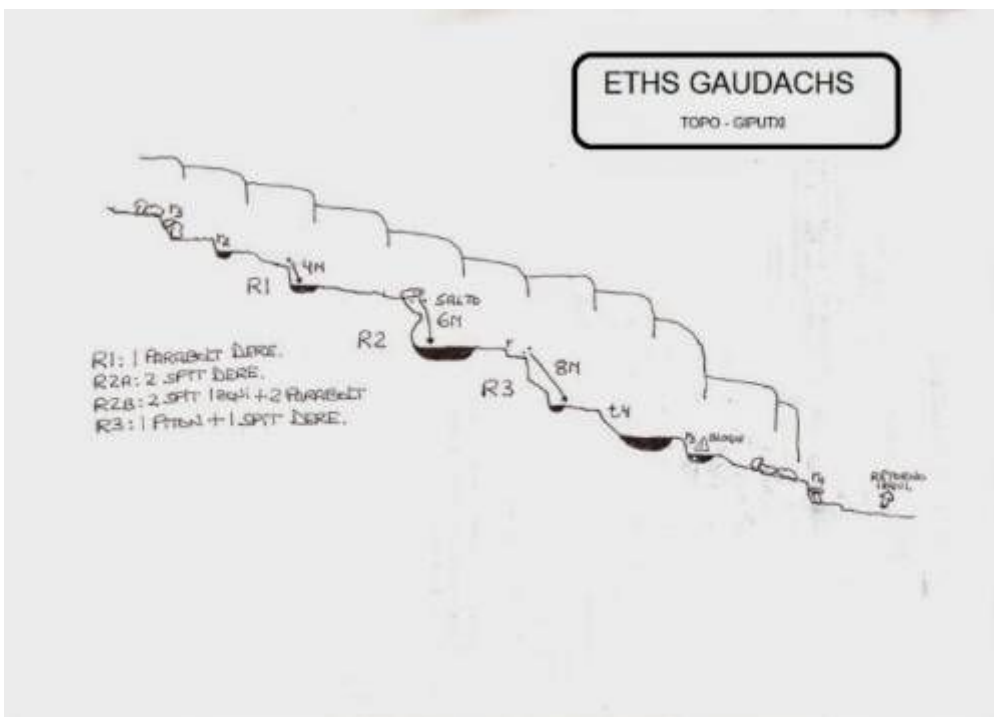
