### **Summary:** (machine translated)

Lime canyon, which is more of a "forest canyon" at the top, but then becomes more and more incised with beautiful passages and a final waterfall of 60m. As of June 2023, the stands in the upper part are in need of renovation, but the further you get in the canyon, the better the stands get (chain anchors throughout). This is a canyon that should be done when there is a lot of water in the area and perhaps other canyons (such as Zemola) are not possible due to the water level. The exit is a popular attraction in the region because there is a dinosaur footprint.

## **Hydrology:**

### Access: (machine translated)

From Claut continue into Val Cellina (same direction as to Ciolesan). At the Ciolesan parking lot, follow the road for another 15 minutes up the sometimes narrow hairpin bends until the road becomes a gravel road and you come to the "Casavento" parking lot. In summer the parking lot is often very busy because Casavento is a popular attraction.

### **Approach:** (machine translated)

From the parking lot "Casavento" to the hut "Casavento", stay on the path (do not go in the direction of the stream) and follow the path for about 25 minutes until you reach the stream at about 1120m and follow the barely recognizable path into the canyon for about 50m.

### **Tour:** (machine translated)

The start of the tour is more of a forest canyon with some outdated stands (as of June 2023). However, the tour gradually gains in character with some narrow sections and beautiful abseils. Some slides and jumps are also possible. The tour ends with a 60m rappel into a deep pool, where tourists are often encountered in summer, as footprints of dinosaurs are visible directly at the exit.

### Return: (machine translated)

Follow the path for about 10 minutes back to the parking lot.
