Vertical tour which is nice and can be done directly after the rain, but the anchors need to be renewed.

Hydrology: (machine translated)

Small catchment area in the limestone, it doesn't take long for the water level to come down.

Access: (machine translated)

In Melano there is a parking lot near the exit. Otherwise in Rovio at the top, the parking lot is free there, but you have to climb 200m again after the canyon.

Approach: (machine translated)

Follow the hiking trail up to Alpe Melano and then join the trail at the stream.

Tour: (machine translated)

At the beginning there are many wide rappels from trees, after the 120m waterfall it becomes narrower and very beautiful. Unfortunately, at the final waterfall of 180m, a large boulder has slipped on the right side and an intermediate belay is no longer there. It would make sense to redrill this intermediate stand on the left side. At the point where it is currently on the right, the rope gets stuck in the waterfall and it is difficult to get it down.

Return: (machine translated)

Follow the streambed for 5 minutes and then turn right onto the path.
