Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From the A 1 (Florence - Rome) at the Fabro exit (23.5 km north of the Orvieto exit) turn east to Fabro Scala, from there continue towards Parrano. About 5 km after leaving the A1, the road crosses a stream. Just after the bridge we follow the signpost 'Tane del Diavolo' on a dirt road that takes us (finally over a small bridge) to the parking area at the exit of the canyon. There you will find a wooden house where the via ferrata is 'managed' through the canyon		
Approach: (machine translated) We cross the stream below the large final pumping station, leave the water catchment on the right and climb the footpath in a northerly direction. We come to a wire mesh fence with a locked door. Either we open this door by paying a fee for the via ferrata or we crawl under the fence (above or below the door) as inconspicuously as possible. We follow the path inside the fence uphill, leave the access to the via ferrata (at the natural arch) on the right and reach the upper part of the fence on increasingly sparse tracks. Go back down, then directly along the fence slightly downhill to the right until a gap opens up in the fence after about 200m. Through the gap in an easterly direction to the stream, which we enter directly below the small dam.		
Tour: (machine translated) Preferably before mid-May if water flow is desired. See photos and video		
Return: (machine translated) After the exit of the canyon and the last big pool fed by a karst spring, out to the parking lot.
