The Capra Waterfall, also known as the Iezerului Waterfall, is located on the southern slope of the Făgăraş Mountains, near Lake Bâlea. With an impressive height of 115 meters, it forms a steep wall from top to bottom, alternating between vertical drops and inclined planes. This waterfall can be descended either as a standalone experience or as a continuation of the Capra Canyon, following a roughly 20-minute walk along the valley from the exit of the upper section.
