Summary: (machine translated)

Little fattened and generally dry but very nice rappels, continuous, without rest, if we catch it with water is a delight. We will be able to arrive until the Canaletes and to enjoy an aquatic time.

Hydrology: (machine translated)

At the 6th rappel

Access: (machine translated)

By the N430 or by the C43 if we go from Tortosa. We will arrive at Gandesa and we will turn off to Bot by the TV3531.

Once in the village we can park here if we want to combine cars returning by the Canaletes.

With the access car and if the track is good, we will go along Verge de la Fontcalda street to cross the greenway through a tunnel. We will continue to cross the Candesa bank by the bridge and continue along the track, after a very sharp right turn we will take the track on the left and after 200m also the track on the left to then leave a track on the left and head for the cami de Vollandins that already goes along the top of the slope.

After 3kms of track we will see that this widens and that you can no longer continue straight ahead. We park. You could leave your car at the old station of Prat de Comte and return crossing the Canaletes.

Approach: (machine translated)

We will continue along the path that goes straight ahead through the cliffs. In less than 1 km we will arrive at the trailhead (we must be attentive).

Tour: (machine translated)

Without rest 6 rappels to return under the cuttings.

You can do two more rappels and end up at the Canaletes but this option requires a combination of vehicles or a lot of walking.

Return: (machine translated)

Several options:

1.- Crossing the Canaletes to the old station of Prat de Comte (combination of vehicles).

2.- Across the Canaletes to take the green way.

3.- After the R40 (6th abseil) go right under the cliffs to look for a path through the forest. It is not very marked but following the track or some milestones placed we will not get lost. It takes us up to the car track.

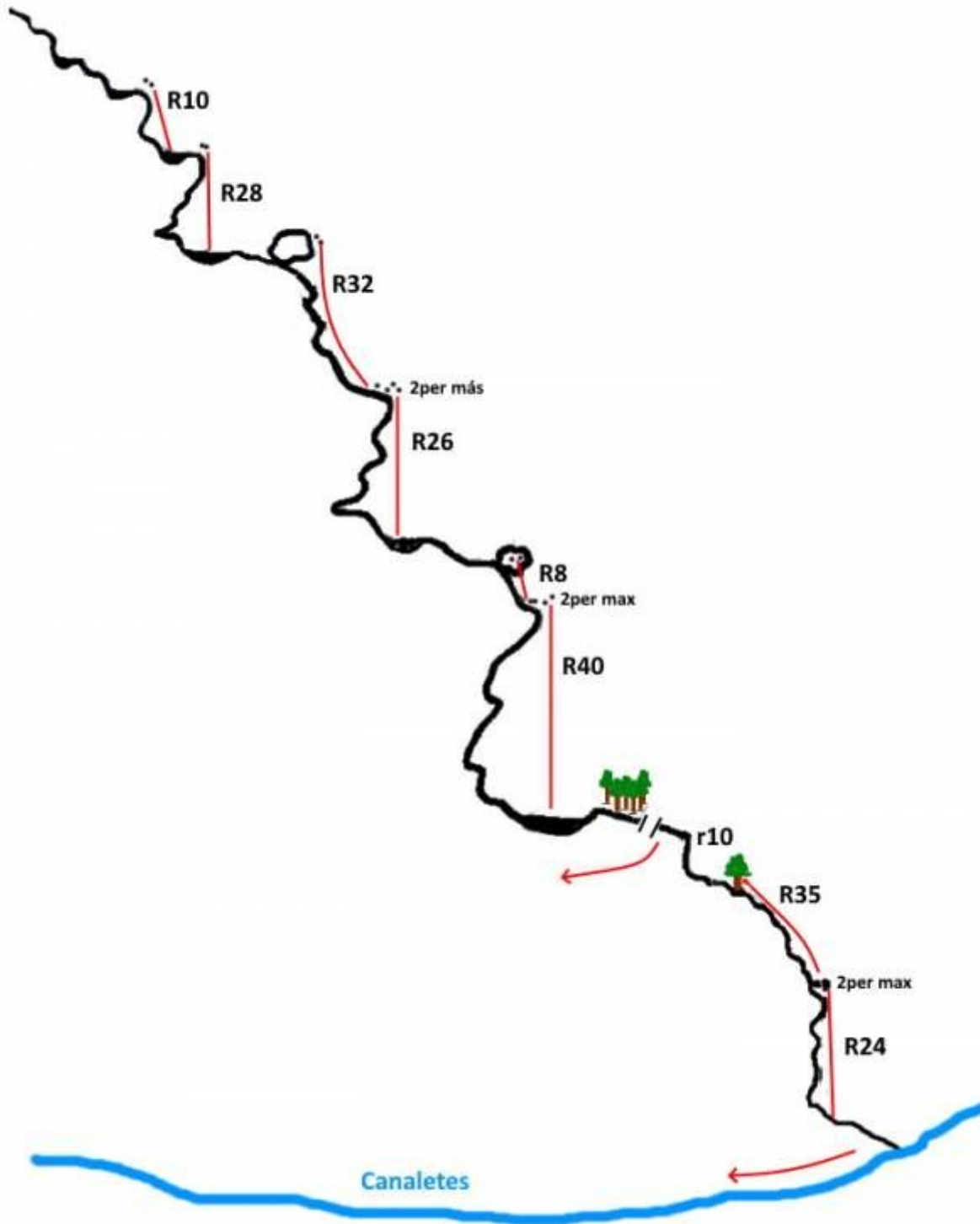
