**Summary:** (machine translated)

Located in the Puerto de la Sía, it is a ravine very frequented by the companies of the place given its easy access and return, the relatively simple development, its good formations, etc. However, in times of heavy rains it can get very technical in the boxed area if we catch it with high flows.

It would be possible to combine cars to save a kilometer and a half on the road.

Much better out of the summer to ensure a good flow.

**Hydrology:** (machine translated)

**Access:** (machine translated)

We must be located in the Portillo de la Sía, on the Cantabrian side, just at km 7. On the way up there is an esplanade on our left where we can park

**Approach:** (machine translated)

From the esplanade we head north between the stone walls following a small path that soon turns right to go into the beech forest, where it will lose its trace. Without losing height we cross a first stream, we leave the beech forest and reach a larger riverbed, our descent.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Open at the beginning and with short rappels, little by little the descent will be more substantial until we reach the boxed area, where we will find the waterfall of almost 30m. From here it opens again to make the 3 remaining rappels.

Strong friction in the rappel of 20 for breakage of the head by fall of stones, has been jagged and sharp the slab.

It is not possible to make the slide there is a great trunk that crosses, it is necessary to rappel from the previous head (R18).

**Return:** (machine translated)

When we reach the track/path that crosses the river, we take it to the left. We will go up it for more than 2kms to the road, here we could leave the car of return if we want to make a combination of cars.

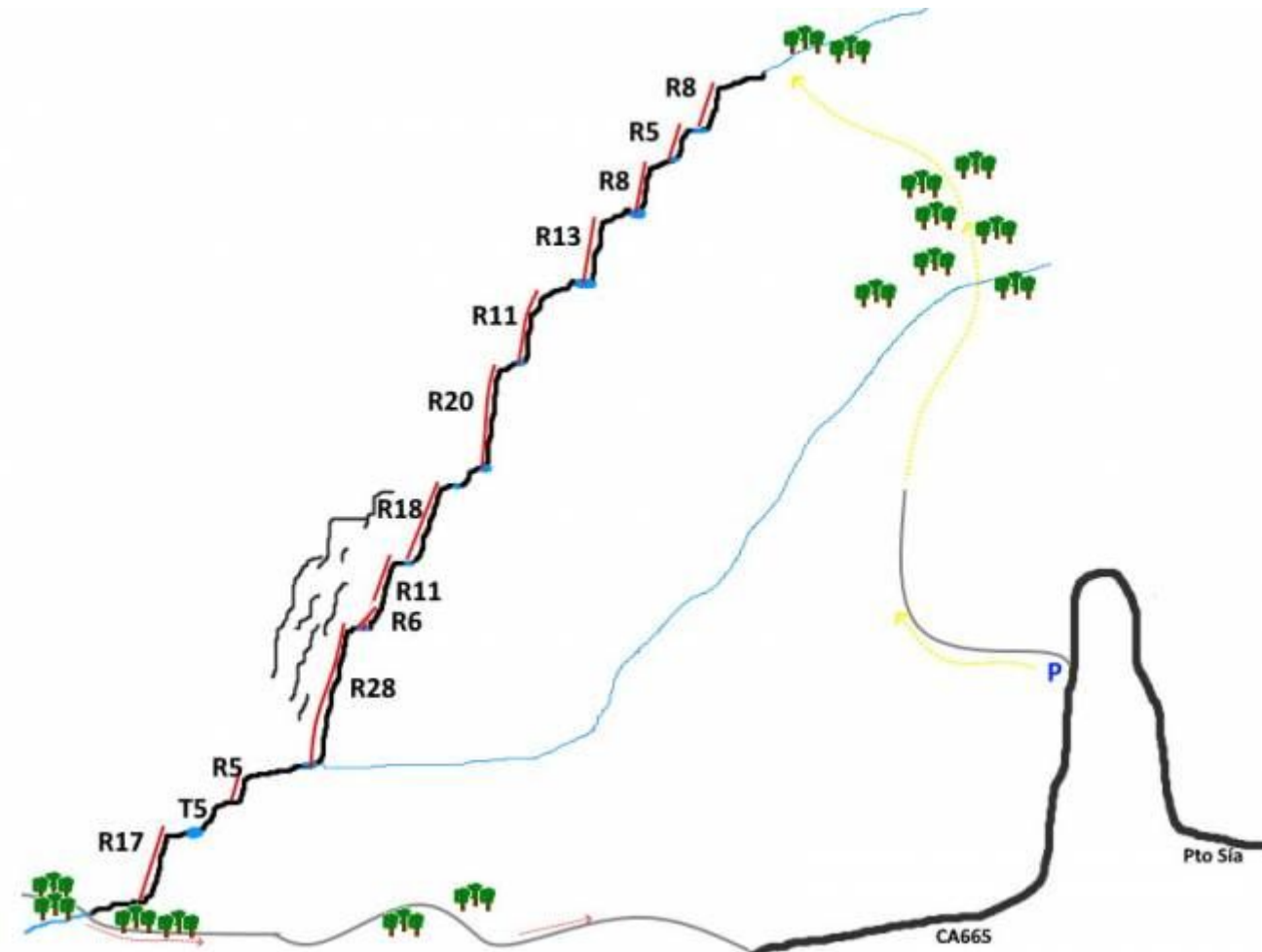
On the road we will go to the left, ascending, to reach our car.
