<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Ravine of the Aralar mountain range, at the foot of the Txindoki, a unique enclave for a ravine that is only fattened in certain sections (head and intermediate). Provide material for reinstallation or replacement.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) Several except in the most fattened areas		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From the A1, we take the GI2131 to Alegría. Continue on the GI2133 to Amezketa. We cross the village and take the detour to Hileria or further on the detour to the right to Aralar and Astamutileta. Shortly after, an unpaved track leads us to the bridge where we must park.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) On the other side of the bridge there is a path that goes up to the head of the ravine. Just follow it. Shortly after starting the ascent we will arrive at a hut (borda de Anduitz) which is the return point of the ravine.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) The descent is steep in some parts and with a lot of vegetation in others. It always carries water and is quite slippery. In its intermediate section it has easy escapes to the right to take the access road.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) Exit to the right to the indicated gunwale.
