Spectacular waterfall of 60m over the Douro in the Arribes area that in case of good flow will make us enjoy a really technical descent. Not suitable for inexperienced people. In summer it dries up and loses a lot of interest.

We have to place ourselves in Vilarinho dos Galegos, belonging to Mogadouro.

When we enter the village we leave the church behind and the cemetery, turn right and take the track that runs parallel to the pylons, when the track turns left to the south, we will arrive almost at the cut, here the track turns west again, we park.

This same trail begins to descend and again heads a little south, when we reach a sharp right turn, with the riverbed in front of us, we will leave the trail to descend to the riverbed.

Ravine in spring or with good flow, 7 rappels, the first one jumpable. In the second one, if the flow is high we will have to mount handrail by the ledge to the installation outside the active and taking advantage of the diverter. Then we will reach the beautiful R60.

A lot of caution with the headers, very slippery.

Return: (machine translated)

After the last ledge we exit to the left, without trail, trying to climb as "pleasantly" as possible. Halfway up we will see a path that leads to the car track.


