<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Nice water descent in the Sierra de Guara and very close to the beautiful village of Nocito and Tozal de Guara. Badinas, destrepes, slides ... great to go with the kids for a swim or as a return of Bco Cuello as we can leave at any time as the trail crosses the stream ten times.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) Yes, it is very open		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) We are located in Arguis. For it by the A23 or the N330 from Huesca to Jaca we will leave to Arguis. From Arguis we will go towards Belsué to cross the beautiful valley where the Flumen river is born and along the same road we will continue towards the reservoir of Sta María, the abandoned village of Lúsera and the headwaters of the Flumen. We will leave the detour to Lúsera and continue along the road towards the headwaters of the Flumen and the source of Orlato. After passing the pass, we will only have to go down to Nocito, next to the Sanctuary of San Urbéz, an obligatory excursion. When arriving at Nocito before crossing the bridge that separates the two neighborhoods, we will take the track on the right a couple of kilometers to the confluence of the streams (Guatizalema and Pillera).		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Accesses Bcos Cuello and Pillera There is a path next to the sign that indicates the ravine and the Estañonero dam. We will walk these 2 kms of path that crosses the river up to 10 times to reach the badina that we will go around to the right and continue climbing 200m more to the Cueva del Brazo de Mar. All this route will be done in the middle of a magnificent forest. If we carry a headlamp we will be able to enter the cave.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Pools, waterfalls, jumps and small waterfalls for everyone. A good swim in summer.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) At any time we can leave the access trail or follow the river to the parking lot.
