On the CV20 at pk 21 we turn towards Argelita on the CV194.

From the village we continue along the CV194, leaving the Lucena turnoff (CV193) on the right. At the pk 13.6 there is a sharp turn to the left and on our right the exit of Barranco Hondo, a little to the right there is a place to park the return car.

If we have only one car we will continue to Ludiente and at the exit at the fronton or a little further up the track at the cemetery, we will park.

If we have two cars we follow the road until almost pk 23, a sharp left turn, we have the old road on the right and soon a track on the right, follow this track to the Mas de Vicenta.

Approach: (machine translated)

Access to Hondo and Escalera ravines

With one from the fronton, by the asphalted track that goes up to the cemetery, we follow this path to the Mas de la Pobla (always on the right) and after the Mas de la Pobla, about 50m to the left there is a path that goes up to the Mas de la Noguereta and here takes the track that leads us to the Mas de la Vicenta.

From the Mas de la Vicenta we will follow the track straight ahead until it gets lost as it descends to the riverbed.

We will end up descending almost between brambles

Tour: (machine translated)

Fun descent if we catch it with water, several areas of jumps and small dexterity and slides. The best thing is its waterfall of 40 sections in 15+30m.

Return: (machine translated)

After the confluence with the Escalera or Noguereta ravine, we reach the Vistahermosa river, go up it a little and climb up to the road. If we have two cars, the return car will be here. If not we have to walk to the village

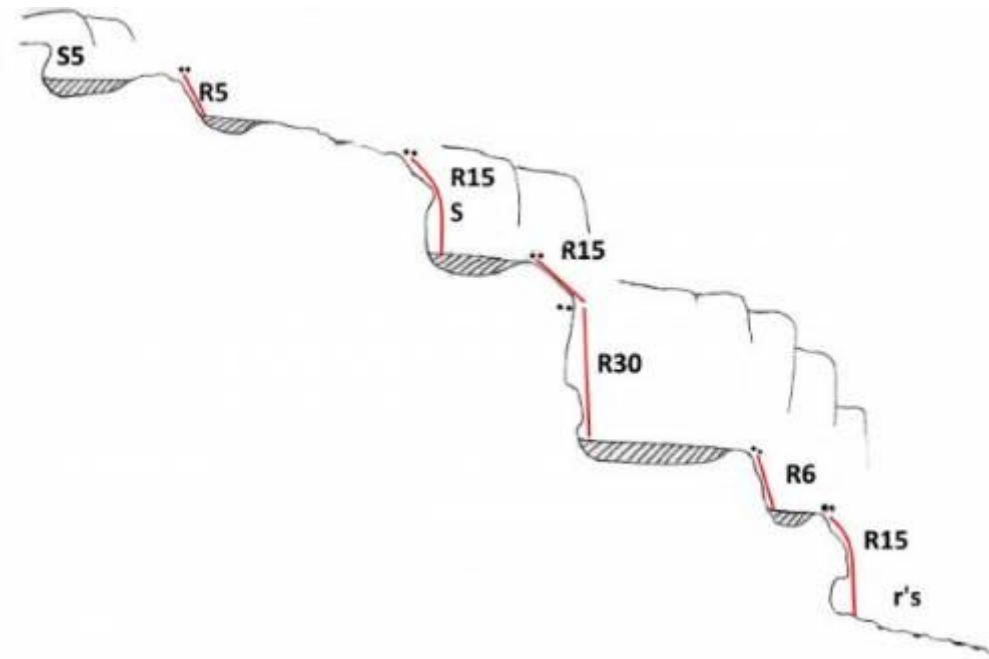
