Nice dry canyon that plunges into the Júcar. Not suitable for beginners because of its long fractional rappels. It is located in the same area as others to access from Jalance so we can combine them very easily. There is no return path along the Júcar and the subsequent ascent is as it is... to take it into account ;)

We must be located in Jalance by the N330.

Access Bcos Jalance

Entering from the side of Requena by the old national road we will arrive inside the village at a sharp left turn where we have the detour to the right towards the Cueva de Don Juan and the Mirador de los Cañones del Júcar. We will follow the signs to the Cueva de Don Juan as we leave the village.

Once out of the village we will reach a sharp right turn with a road ahead (Cueva de Don Juan).

We will go through some hairpin bends through which we will climb to the top. One kilometer later, through the crop fields, we will have a detour. To the right we will go to the Cave and the Mirador, parking lots of Alejo Gómez, Largo, Capellanes... and Useros. On the left 6kms we would go to the Moragete.

We will park at the Mirador del Júcar.

Approach: (machine translated)

Bcos (left to right) Carrasca, Useros, Robles, Capellanes, Largo, Alejo Gómez

We go out to the road to the right, to the cave, after a few meters the road turns to the right to go around the riverbed, we will continue straight on until the riverbed.

Tour: (machine translated)

Vertiginous in its rappels, almost without rest. If we don't fractionate we can have problems in the recovery of ropes and unnecessary friction.

Return: (machine translated)

When we get to the river we will cross it and go left orographically to the dam. There we will cross the river and go up the path that, climbing steeply, leads us to the viewpoint.

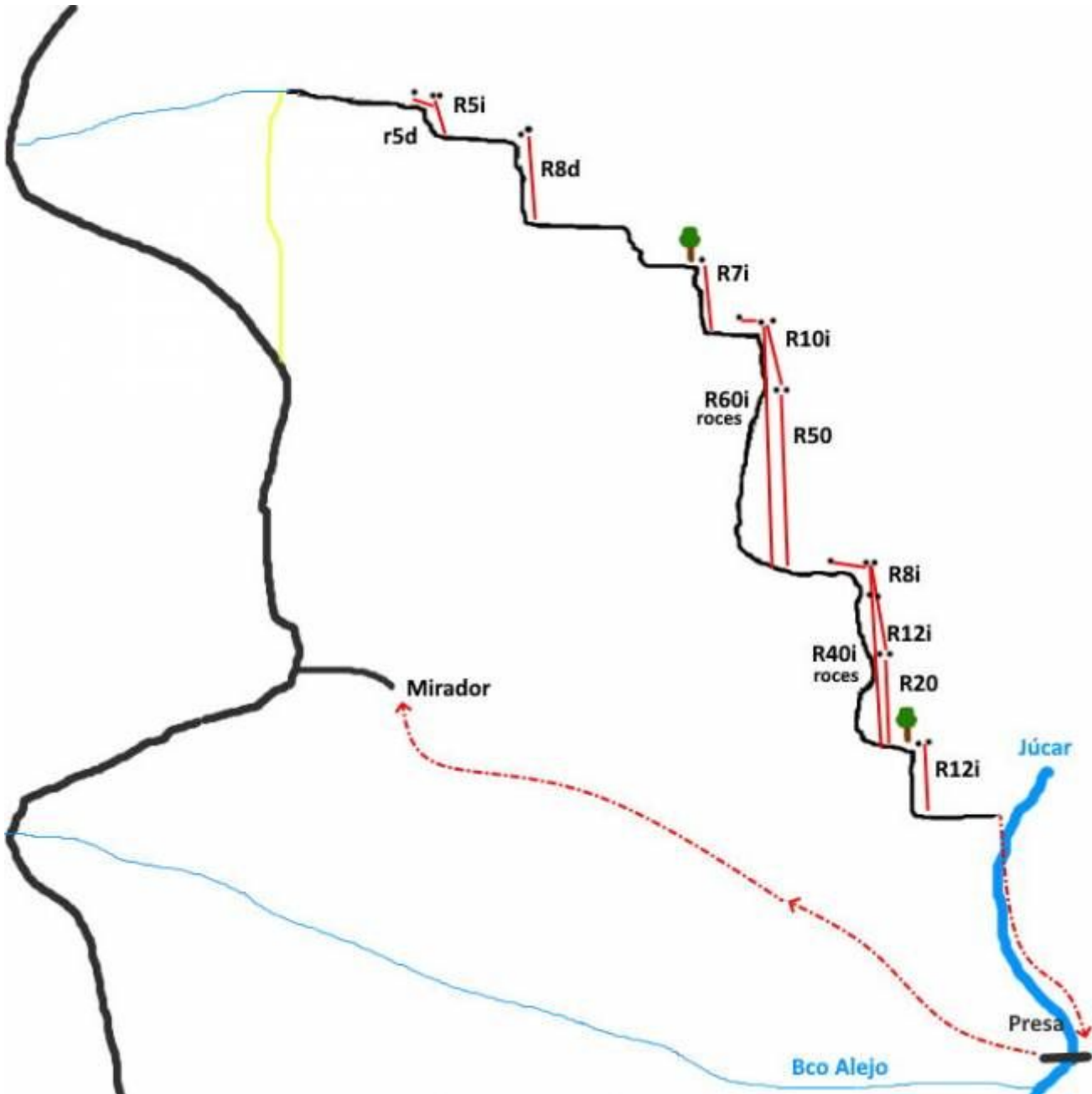
