Very vertical canyon, with natural facilities. It is worth it for its spectacular waterfall of 75m fractioned.

The Clotet is an alpine canyon, short but very vertical, located in a privileged enclave within the Route of the Three Waterfalls of Cerler (Ardonés, Clotet and Mascarada), an open and panoramic environment that stands out for its stunning views over the valley of Benasque.

The descent is technical and continuous. Its highlight is the great 75-meter fractional waterfall, which offers a spectacular vertical sensation and a unique view of the landscape.

The combination of Clotet with the neighboring Mascarada canyon allows you to enjoy a full day, linking two different but complementary descents, in one of the most unique places in the Aragonese Pyrenees.

As of June 2024, the facilities are in good condition.

**Access:** (machine translated)

Take the N260 to Castejón de Sos, where we turn off to Benasque on the A139.

Access to the Mascarada and Clotet bcos.

We cross Benasque and continue along the road. At the traffic circle we turn to Cerler, we pass the village towards the slopes.

At pk 9.4 we have a sharp right curve and a track to the left along the slope. We take it and park at the end, in Bco Ardonés.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Access to the Mascarada and Clotet banks

We cross the ravine and along a path that comes out on the opposite bank we go about 1 km until we reach an old track. Here we turn right onto a path that this time goes up the slope towards the head of Mascarada and Clotet.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Vertical descent, almost without rest we will have 3 rappels that will bring us closer to the great waterfall of 75m that is fractioned (from trees). Caution with rope recoveries.

It is a fairly open descent so we will have magnificent views throughout the route.

**Return:** (machine translated)

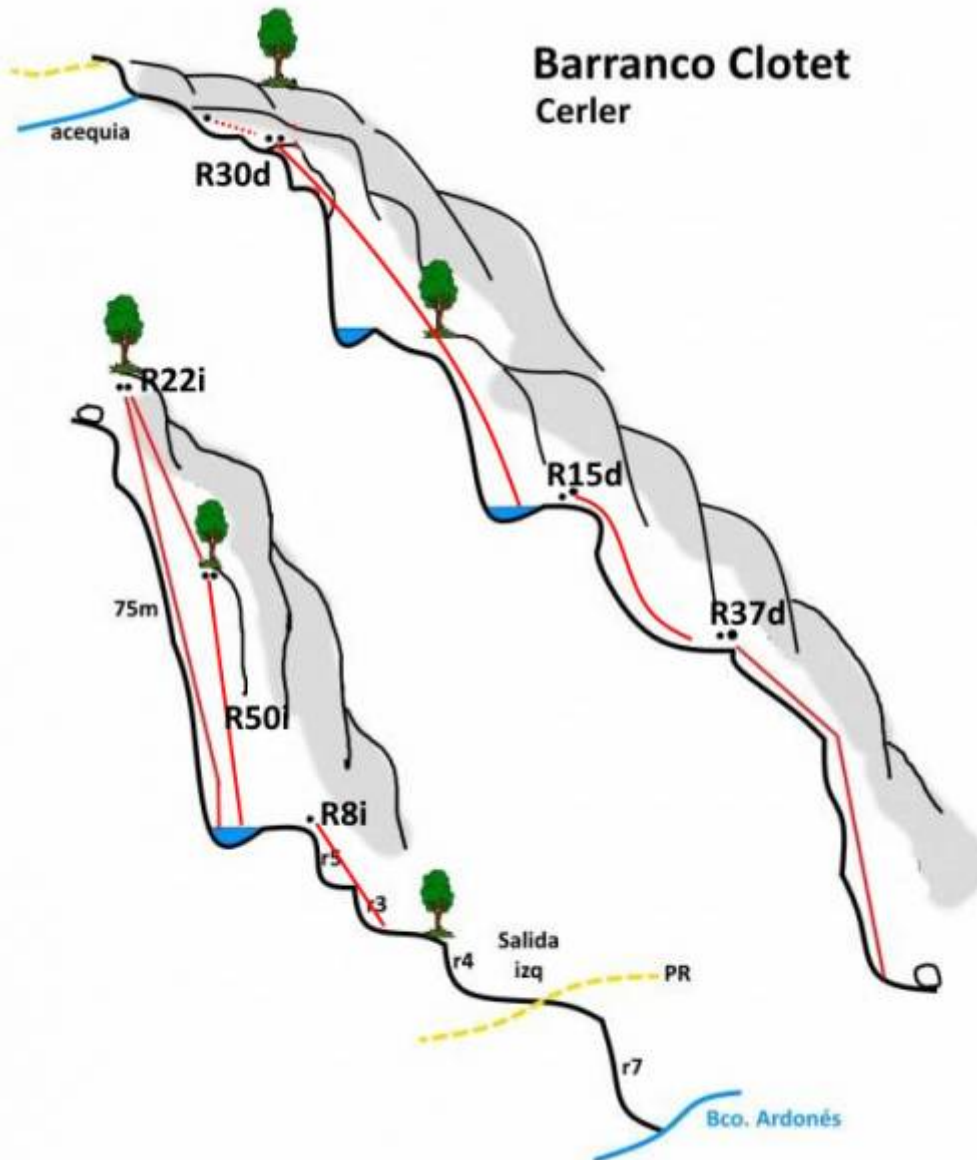
After the last projections we will see a path (PR) that crosses. We can go left by the Ardonés waterfall to cross the bridge and follow the trail to the parking lot. Or go right to the exit of Mascarada and from there down to the parking lot.
