We have to be located in San Vicente de Piedrahita on the CV196. On the CV20 until almost the Arenoso reservoir, at p.k. 51.4 next to Montanejos, there is a road on the right that crosses a bridge CV195 to Zucaina. 51.4 next to Montanejos, there is a road on the right that crosses a bridge CV195 to Zucaina. We will go along this road almost until km 8, here there is a detour to the left to San Vicente.

Once in the village we will have to get into the street behind the Red Cross, following this street becomes a road that heads north. After a kilometer we have a couple of sharp bends (left-right) to go down to the stream bed and a few meters before a track that goes off to the left. We will go down the track for about 600m with the Garranchosa ravine on our left, we leave it behind and after a kilometer the track ends and we park.

Approach: (machine translated)

By a small path heading west, very obvious because it is simply to go down to the riverbed.

Tour: (machine translated)

Fattened, very well formed, but without great difficulties and generally without water.

Return: (machine translated)

When the gorges open, we will turn left onto a track, along which we will go about 400m to a path on the left that goes up the slope. Following it north, we will arrive at the rest of a track that leaves us where we have parked.
