Gully without great interest except for the Salto de la Vieja, vertical of 55m.
It could be combined with the Faixas canyon.

Hydrology: (machine translated)

Yes, but the wooded environment can be complicated.

Access: (machine translated)

On the N240 between Jaca and Pamplona, just to reach Puente de la Reina we have the detour to the Valle de Hecho (A176).

We will cross the village of Hecho and continue climbing towards the Selva de Oza, we will have halfway, on the right the detour to the refuge of Gabardito and borda Bisaltico.

Approach: (machine translated)

We will leave by the GR towards El Foratón and before arriving we will turn to the left by the path that goes up the Secús ravine towards the Agüerri Peak, this path crosses the Agüerri ravine, moment to access the riverbed.

Tour: (machine translated)

Soon the Salto de la Vieja, an impressive 55m waterfall, after which we can try to find a way to escape to the left in search of the GR. Or we will continue along the riverbed, a chaos of blocks with nothing remarkable until the last two rappels.

Return: (machine translated)

After the R20 we go left to look for a path that leads us to one of the first forks of the road.

We have the option of following the riverbed almost to the river, where we will have a track on the left that takes us to the bridge of Santa Ana.

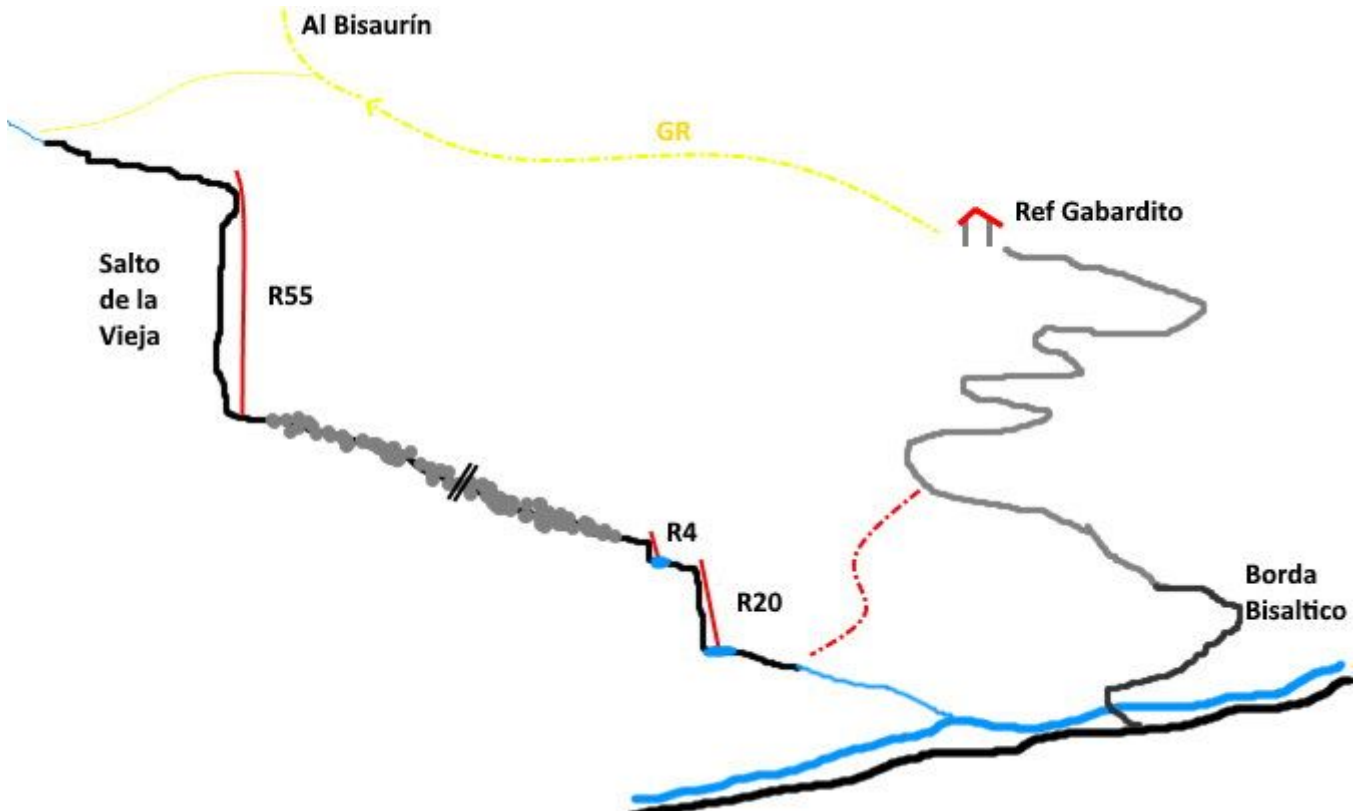
