We crossed the river and went up to the road to return to the car.

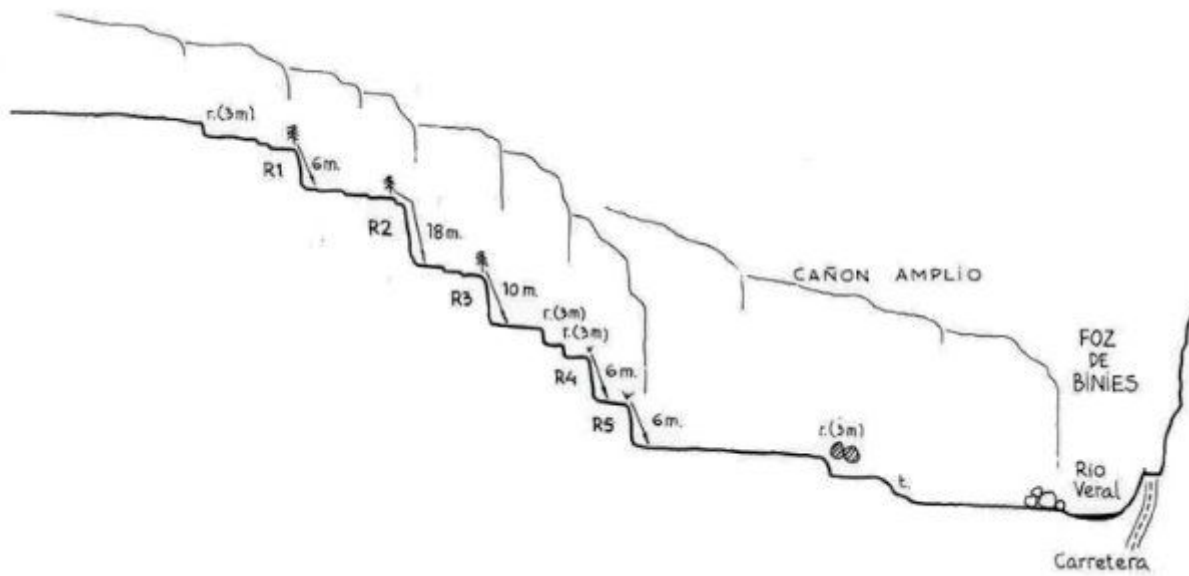
