Summary: (machine translated) Short but very well formed ravine, so much so that we will be surprised how little known it is, with a small cave in the middle of the route.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Before the staggered area		
Access: (machine translated) We are located in Arenas de Cabrales on the AS-114. We will take the detour that comes out in the center of the village to the AS-345 to Arangas. 2, we leave some warehouses on the right and in a left curve we will see a track on the right and a place to park. Here we leave the car of return or if we only have one. We will continue with the other car towards Arangas, we pass the village and just before p.k. 6 we find the stream to descend. 6 we find the stream to descend. We have a small partadero to the left where to park.		
Approach: (machine translated) Along a small path next to the stream up to the first ledge.		
Tour: (machine translated) A rappel and a cliff before entering the boxed area, once in it you can not get out and even have a small cave.		
Return: (machine translated) Just when the gorge opens, it meets another stream on the left. We cross to the other bank and we will find a track to return to the car.
