<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Dry canyon, short, but very vertical. Perfect for lovers of big verticals and hanging installations.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> No		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) We will have to get to Tarbena. From Benidorm or from Alcoy we will take the CV70 towards La Nucia. When arriving at La Nucia we will continue by the CV70 to Polop and from here the CV715 to Callosa d'En Sarrià. From Altea by the CV755 we will also go directly to Callosa. Once in Callosa we take the CV715 towards Bolulla, we cross it following the road towards the beautiful village of Tárbena. Once in the village we will look for the cemetery and park at the entrance.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Looking at the cemetery we will go out to the right to go down through the fields to the riverbed. We will follow the riverbed towards the vertical until we find the first rapel.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) There are those who comment that in the first part there is a lot of bramble that prevents us from advancing well... We arrive at a first rapel of 12m that we will lengthen, to be sure, until we reach the second rapel almost at the vertical. With the second rapel we reach the first overhanging belay. From here another 9m to reach the magnificent R42-43 with its also hung meeting.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) As we descend the last rapel, we will see a pipe on the left. Follow it up the steep slope to the cemetery.

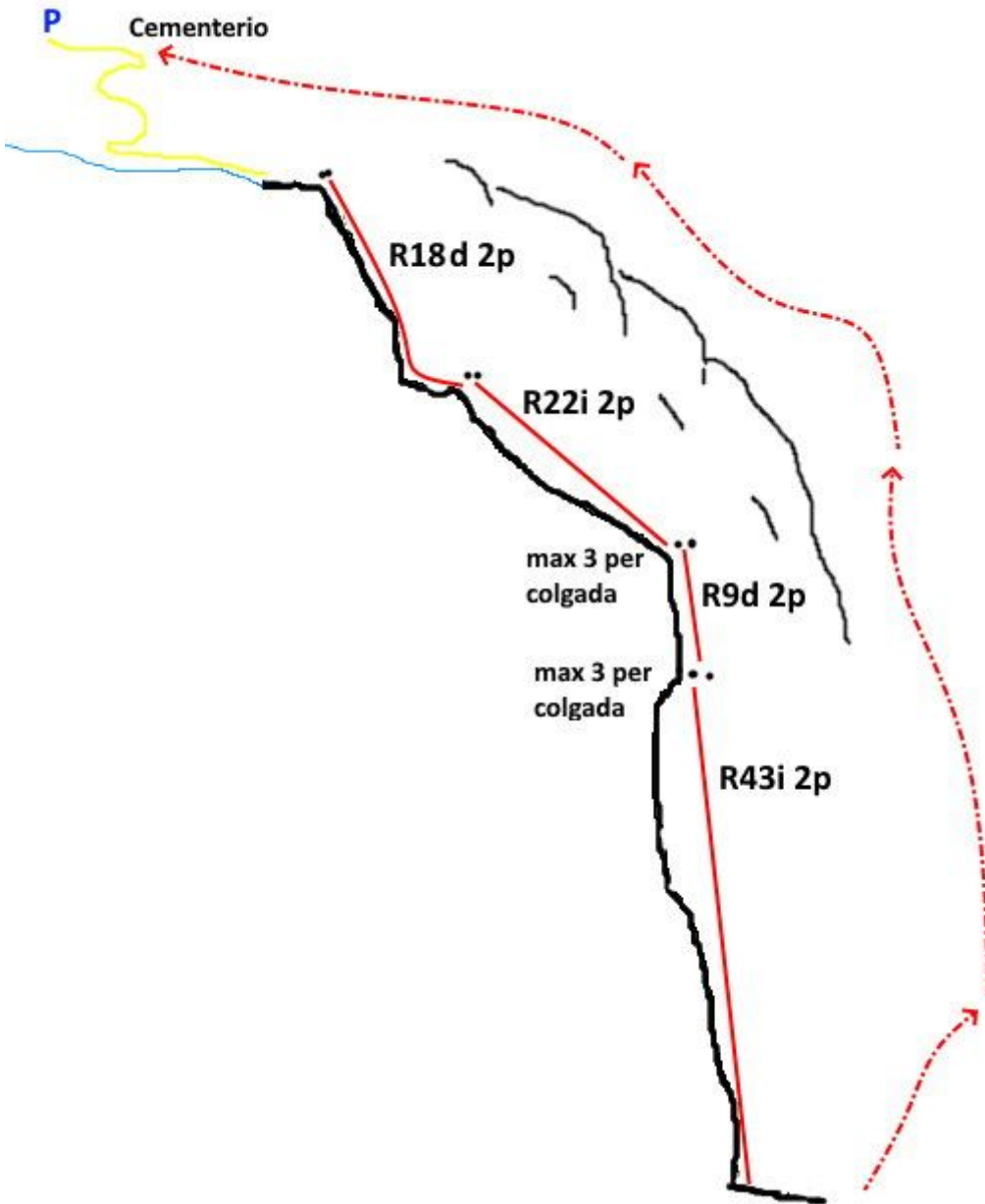
