We are located in Àrnes, on the T330. We will enter by the side of Valderrobles (from the river) to take Aragon Street. After 200m we have a detour to the right to Toll de Vidre that we will take. By this track/road we will go towards the Coll de la Creu here a track comes out on our left, in quite bad condition and after 600m it goes down towards the Caseta de Rabosí where we will park.

Bcos Rabosi area

From the Rabosí hut we will go down the track towards the Gros ravine, when we get down we follow it for about 50m and we will see a path that goes up to the Serrall de Tossetes, through the Racó de Pataqueret leaving the Cova del Fideu on the left.

Access Tomaca and Pataqueret

To the right we have the Salt de les Coves de Tomaca, just to the right is a small path, quite blurred and loser that goes up to the divide, to our right we will see the ravine and its 3 cuts to descend. We will continue ascending until we have surpassed the first cut, from here little by little we will go to the right to descend to the ravine.

3 downhill cuts with walking sections, in rainy spring there may be emergencies.
