From Lecco on the new road to Valsassina to Ballabio. From the traffic circle in the center on the SP 62 about 1km in the direction of Lecco and then turn left on the SP 63. In many serpentines and curves we drive along the edge of the Val Boazzo 12.5 km up to Olino and from here another 3 km to Morterone. Park the car about 100m in front of the church.

Approach: (machine translated)

We go down the road branching off at an acute angle in a northeasterly direction, passing a sinkhole on the left ("Bus de Carigun") and after 500m we come to a farm. Here we turn down to the right, away from the road, passing a homestead on the left and descending along the edge of the meadow. Passing 2 mountain huts, we enter the forest, descend along the left high bank until a track on the right takes us down into the stream.

Tour: (machine translated)

The tour begins after a short river walk with a 26 m - rappel under a rock arch into (after about 10m comfortable intermediate stand). This is followed by a narrowing with small drops, which can be partially jumped.

Return: (machine translated)

At the picnic area, opposite the watery karst spring on the right slope, exit to the left onto the trail. Follow the path uphill back to the starting point, keeping to the left at each junction.
