Beginner-suitable hiking and rappel canyon, (very) narrow gorge passages alternate with open passages. Above the described entry point also set up (see video).

**Hydrology:**

**Access:** (machine translated)

From the A23 highway exit Carnia/Tolmezzo direction Tolmezzo, at the traffic circle of Tolmezzo direction Verzegnis and over the Sella Chianzutan into the upper Arzino valley to San Francesco and on towards Pielungo. Lower parking lot: Immediately after the bridge over the Arzino, turn right onto a sand road and follow it to the bridge over the Rio D'Agaviva.

Upper parking lot: Follow the road to Pielungo - at the exit of the village turn right towards 'Castello Ceconi'. Park at the picnic area.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Entry directly at the picnic area.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Small jump still under the bridge, then a first 4m rappel (glued anchor on the right). After a short walking passages follows a first gorge with a 12m waterfall (tree on the right). Then another walking passages before you reach a longer gorge with some tight turns (no belays, jumps, slides and downclimb passages). The gorge exits with a narrow 12m waterfall into a longer pool (spit on the left). After that, it's just walking passages to the mouth of the Arzino.

**Return:** (machine translated)

Through the streambed to the mouth of the Arzino. You can also try to go out of the canyon to the right to reach the road indicated on the map or to go directly into the Rio Carlo Gasparini.
