<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Also known as Bco. Ligerero or Barranco de Canales by its toponymy. It is a canyon usually dry, simple and vertical, with 16 rappels in a row. Nice views at all times of the Canales reservoir, good formations and quite well equipped. Generally we will find it dry except immediately after heavy rains.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> Posibles		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) We leave Granada towards the ski slopes of Sierra Nevada on the A395. At the p.k. 13.5 we have the detour to the left to Canales, we will go down this street until the parking lot at the end. Here we leave the return car. With the access car we return to the road and continue until p.k. 16 where the Hotel-Restaurant is. 16 where the Hotel-Restaurant la Higuera is, here we park the access car.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the parking lot there is a track on the left that will approach the riverbed, just follow the dry bed of the ravine to a dam and soon the first rappel.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) It is a relentless succession of more or less short rappels, many of them with handrails, very well installed.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) After the last rappel a small path on the left that does not lose height will approach us, from the heights, to the reservoir, and just there we will find an asphalted track that taking to the left takes us up to our parking lot. (02.03.2024)Through the gate that gives access to the reservoir (37.1559632, -3.4779296) just below Plaza de Andalucía 18191, it has been forbidden to leave for some time. The alternative way out that we were told was to take a path on the left hand side before passing the tunnel, and then go out above Plaza de Andalucía 18191 (although they did not specify the exact height).

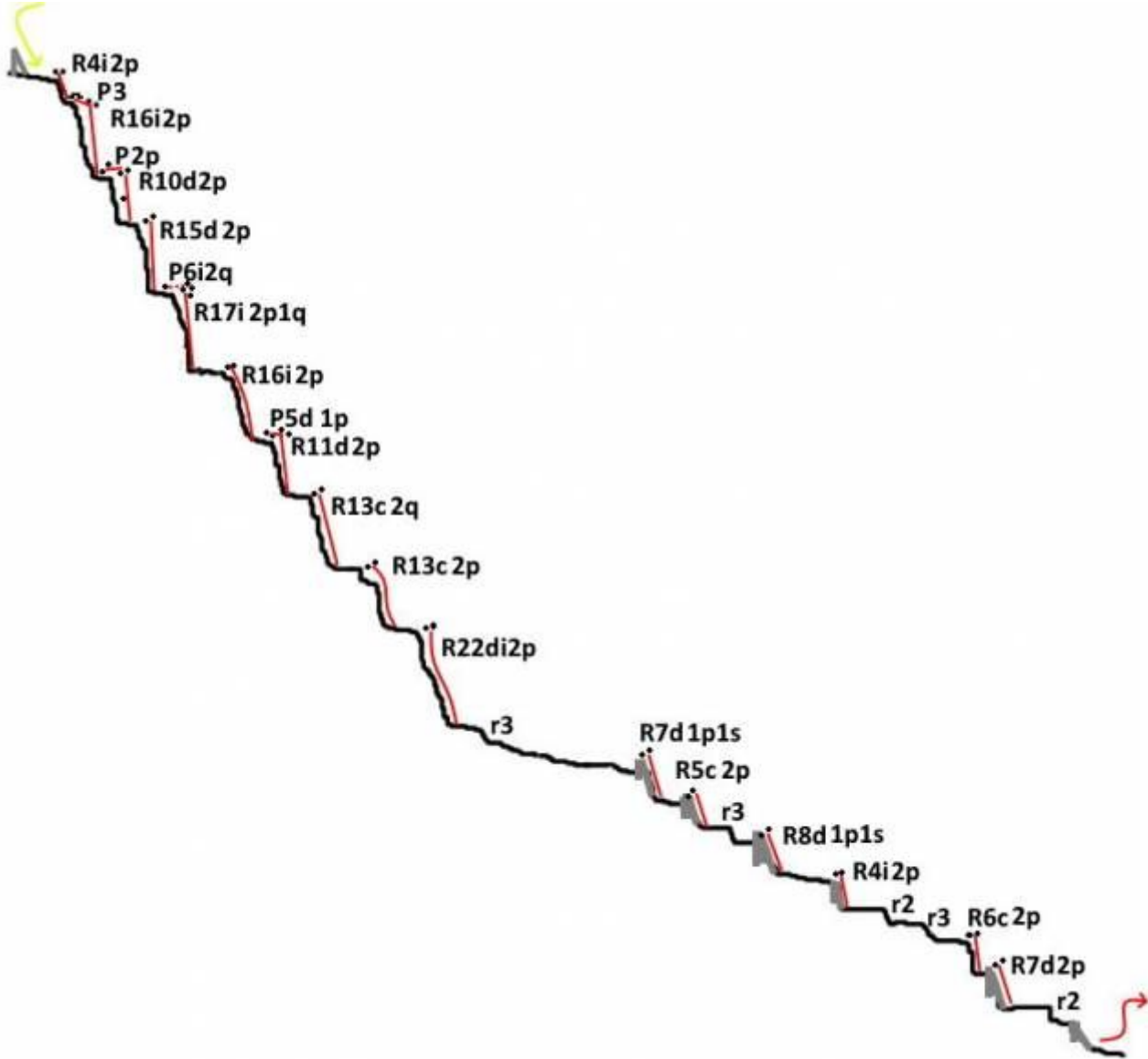
