Also called Ubago or by its spectacular final waterfall, the Bom waterfall. Little known and frequented descent, with only 3 rappels, a lot of flow in thaws and a vertiginous final rappel, due to its height and the strength of the water.

Perfect to combine with Mascarada and Clotet.

It is not a descent for inexperienced people.

**Access:** (machine translated)

Take the N260 to Castejón de Sos, where we turn off to Benasque on the A139.

Access to the Mascarada and Clotet bcos.

We cross Benasque and continue along the road. At the traffic circle we turn to Cerler, we pass the village towards the slopes.

At pk 9.4 we have a sharp right curve and a track to the left along the slope. We take it and park at the end, in Bco Ardonés.

If we have an access car, we continue along the road towards Ampriú and just before p.k. 11 we have on the left the track that leads to Ampriú. 11 we have on the left the track that leads to the waterfall of Ardonés. We will get there until the bridge over our ravine.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Described in the access by car.

From the bridge we will walk along the orographic right of the river until we reach the area where the ravine narrows.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Three rappels, very cold water and the Bom or Ardonés waterfall with its 65m of water.

**Return:** (machine translated)

By the path on the left that gives access to the footbridge where people visit the base of the waterfall.

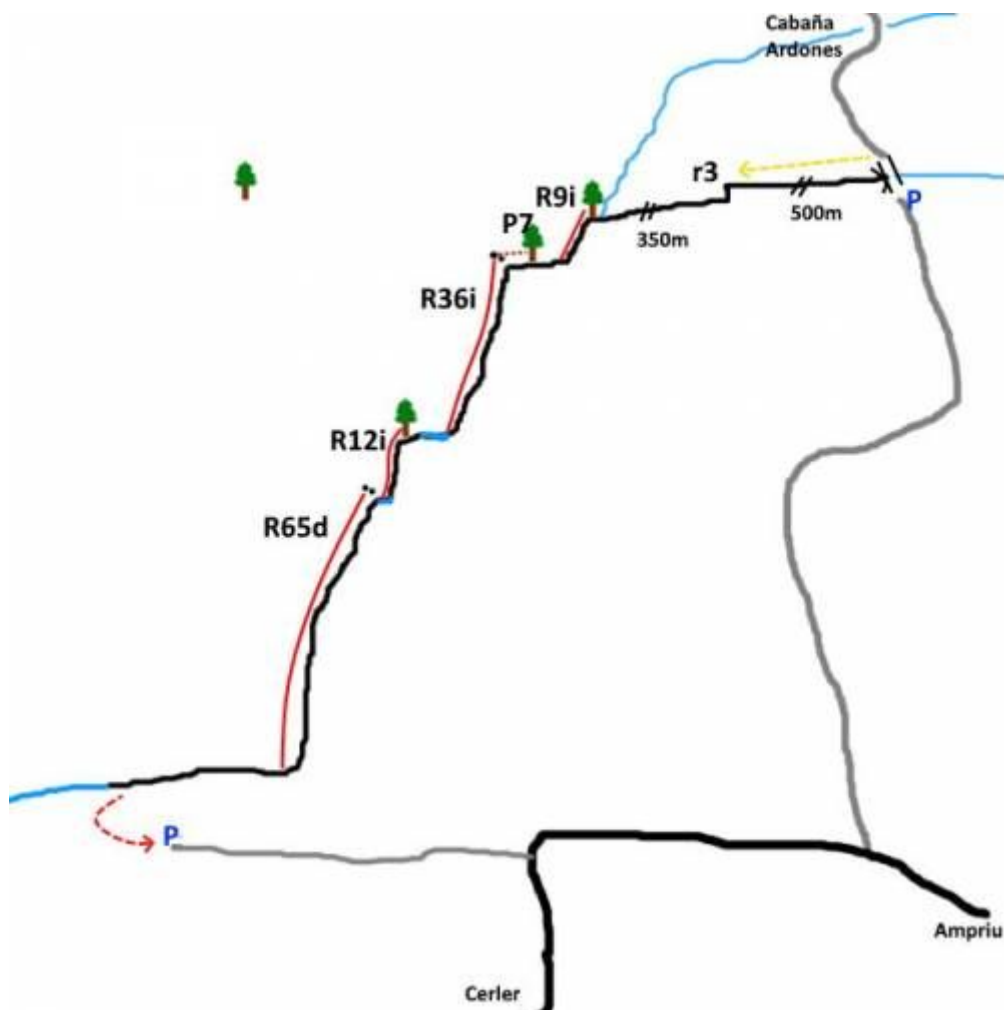
