Very vertical canyon, with impressive views of the Tejea Gorge and with very cold water, perfect for the beginning of summer since it always carries at least a trickle of water.

Access: (machine translated)

Situated between Candeleda and Madrigal de la Vera (CL501), we will arrive at the village of El Raso. We will follow the signs to the Castro until the Mirador de Gredos Restaurant, just outside the village, where we will turn left towards the Castro Vetón de El Raso (reference point in Maps). We will follow this track to the bridge over the Pinillo stream (6.7 kms from El Raso), here the track makes a sharp right turn and straight ahead leaves us on the bridge. We park.

Approach: (machine translated)

We leave the track and a few meters to the right by the PR AV 47 to go up the slope. After passing a hut (and the viewpoint), which we will reach in 1h, we will continue a little more the ascent, to see, already on our left, the bed of the stream, time to get into it over the rocky ledges.

Tour: (machine translated)

Large descent, almost all the rappels are long although they are not too vertical, but very slippery, like almost all the descents in the area.

The last rappel is the 150m split, we will find the option of descending on both sides, caution when descending and evaluate very carefully if you can continue the descent on the chosen side.

We will continue climbing up to the Tejea gorge.
