Summary:

Long and largely open ditch, with few high points and lots of walking and downclimbing.

Hydrology:

Access:

(machine translated)
A vehicle for the exit of the tour is parked at the Kaiserhaus on the Brandenberger Ache (below the Kaiserklamm gorge). You get there from Kramsach first in the direction of the Sonnwendjoch chairlift, then from the parking lot of the valley station along the orographic right bank of the Brandenberger Ache in the direction of Aschau. After the village sign of Aschau, do not drive into the village, but turn right and continue up the Brandenberger Ache until you reach the large parking lot at the Kaiserhaus (about 13 km from Kramsach).

Take the second vehicle to Kufstein and from there in a north-westerly direction to Thiersee. Via Schmiedthal and Aschendorf you reach Landl (about 9 km from Vorderthiersee). Immediately after the village, turn left over the Thiersee Ache and up to Riedenberg (a good 5 km from Landl). Turn right at the first houses and park your car at the exit of the row of houses (980 m above sea level).

Approach:

(machine translated)
From the car in a westerly direction on a field path to the forest. Shortly before reaching the forest, take a path half-right uphill above the Karnergraben. After reaching the forest road, turn left (west) on it for about 350m, cross the stream (Karnergraben entry) and immediately afterwards turn right onto a path that leads up to the Riedenbergalm (1400m above sea level). Continue on faint tracks in a westerly direction to the Thaleralm (1435 m above sea level). From here, continue west on the slope until it branches off on the opposite slope. Now head steeply up the slope in a pathless NW direction and on the other side down to the streambed of the upper Weißengraben, which you reach at about 1450 m above sea level.

At the beginning, you can descend for some time to the right of the streambed until you reach the first rappel (from the tree).

Tour:

The ditch is not without scenic charm, especially the access and the return march through the Kaiserklamm gorge, but otherwise only offers a few interesting (narrow) passages. At around 880 m above sea level, the Weißengraben flows into the Eilegger ditch, which descends from the left.

In view of the amount of time required, including for moving the vehicles - preferably the evening before - this is something for lovers of combined tours and collectors.

Return: (machine translated)

At the bridge, shortly before reaching the Brandenberger Ache, go out to the left or right, then wade through the Brandenberger Ache and follow the path on the far bank (orographic. right) downstream. The path leads us through the Kaiserklamm gorge to the Kaiserhaus.
