Access Canaletes

We must be located in Cabrera d'Anoia (Canaletes).

On the C15 between Igualada and Vilafranca del Penedés, at pk32 we have the detour to Canaletes, we take it and cross the village. We will pass the last houses and we will see a track on the left with a signpost to the Salt de la Mala Dona. The first stream we cross is the Torrent de Bleda and the second the Torrent de Guitza.

We park here and we can do both even in a long morning.

Access to Guitza and Bleda ravines

We will continue to the second stream and a few meters before we will see a cairn on a path from which we access the first rappel from a tree.

Only 4 rappels, the first of the Freda from a tree, second Guitza and finally the fractioned Salt del Cups.

We will take a path on the left with blue marks that will lead us to the trail.
