Famous for its confluence with the Jordan, it usually escapes everyone's attention for being less sporty. A way to extend the day by doing both combinations. It can also be accessed by the tributary making a nice R40.

Access: (machine translated)

On the A21 (Pamplona-Jaca), we will turn off at Sigües (Roncal Valley) onto the A137, after passing the Yesa reservoir. We will continue straight on towards Roncal. When we pass Navarra the road becomes the Na137. Continue towards Isaba and then towards France and the Belagua pass. At km43 is the bridge over the river Belagua, shortly before there is a track/road that leads to the Ermita de Arrako. Here we leave the car.

Approach: (machine translated)

Accesses bcos Jordan, Arrakogoiti and afl

By the track that goes towards the hermitage, instead of turning to the right we will continue straight on, next to the Lapatia ravine to take a path that turns to the right and enters the forest heading north over the Arrako river.

Accesses to Jordan, Arrakogoiti and afl

Shortly before the path approaches the river we will cross a tributary (R40) we will be about 1500m of distance, if we continue, we will approach the river and begin the descent.

Tour: (machine translated)

An 18m rappel and a lot of climbing in a different way to access the arrako.

After the last rappel, the ravine opens up and we come to a meadow, we go out to the left and soon we reach a bridge where we cross to the hermitage and the car.


