We are in Alcoy.

We take the CV795 towards Banyeres and just at the exit, after the tunnel, we have the detour to El Salt. We park in the neighborhood

With the return car we will go to the lower bridge and park in an adjacent street.

Approach: (machine translated)

There is a path from the neighborhood that leads down to the waterfall, right next to a pine tree we will find the 3 parabolts (see plates).

Tour: (machine translated)

It is only the vertical, if it carries a lot of flow you can secure access to see if it is feasible to descend from further back. you can go down from the first meeting (90 meters) and recover from above. or do the split (9+80 meters) and recover from below. hanging meeting maximum two people.

Return: (machine translated)

With two cars it is almost immediate.

With a car we will have to go up the waterfall by one of the trails on the orographic right, we have to climb some rocks to reach the path, lots of vegetation.
