Summary: (machine translated) Beautiful gneiss gorge with huge boulders and downclimbs; impressive gneiss formations; several entry and exit options possible; large dam, call ahead! (+41 27 970 59 04) . Adequate protection; mostly not very cold water; most of the sun is in the canyon from midday; emergency exit after 7m jump.				
Hydrology:				
Access: (machine translated) From Brig, drive to Naters. Then follow the asphalted mountain road towards Blatten. After a few hairpin bends, you come to a turn-off to the village of Hegdorn, where you can park your shuttle car at the exit of the road (signposted parking lot). From here, either walk back to the main road and take the bus up to the village of Blatten or take the 2nd car. The bus terminates at Blatten. Then follow the mountain road or path, keeping to the right (towards the dam) until you reach the barrier (no driving sign). There are plenty of parking spaces right in front of the barrier (usually open). (Alternatively, you can drive down to the foot of the dam wall). (Overnight accommodation after the bridge at 1270m). Without a shuttle car, you can either leave your car in Hegdorn (parking lot) and then take the bus up or vice versa (park your car at the entry and take the bus up after the tour). The distance/time from the bus terminus to the canyon or to the car remains the same.				
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot, follow the road to the foot of the mighty dam (1270m). You could start right at the bridge or save yourself the first part (boulder terrain) and follow the hiking trail in the direction of "Bitsch" (orographic left). Leave the path at the point where you reach the beautiful wooden hut. Here you go straight down across the meadow towards the stream. The entry becomes steeper shortly before the stream. (1200m)				
Tour: (machine translated) The Massa Gorge is more of a hiking and swim canyon than a rappel canyon. Nevertheless, the canyon offers beautiful rappels in wonderfully green/bluish pools. The countless downclimbs (some over fixed ropes) never get boring as you have to find your way through crevices and holes. One of the highlights is the rappel (approx. 25m) into the so-called cathedral (left or right belay - exposed) followed by a narrow crevice with steps and a large pool, after which you approach the possible exit. However, there is also the option of exiting the canyon on the right after the last block area at a water drainage and reaching the road via a footbridge/hiking trail.				

Return: (machine translated)

If you're not sure, look up. Here a line leads across the canyon. This 1st exit option requires some easy climbing up to a meadow. Then along the electricity pylons to the small wooden huts. Further up from the huts, you will soon reach a road. Here, either follow the road or the hiking trail signs to the village of Hegdorn. In the small village with the beautiful wooden houses, keep right until you reach the shuttle car or the bus stop. (30-40min). The bus runs every hour (7.04, 7.27, 8.27, 9.27, etc. and costs CHF 3.60).
