Without great verticals but a very remarkable grassy environment, quite well configured and above all solitary, like its neighbors of Baulaya, it is a highly recommended option in rainy seasons in which it gains much interest. <b>Access:</b> (machine translated) We arrive at Lanestosa by the N629 and from here by the BI3622 to Karranza. Or from Bárcena by the CA120. We will go up to Lanzas Agudas by the BI4625 and we will follow the track that comes out at the top of the village, we will take another track that comes out on the left until we can get there by car.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Chorra Grande, Baulaya East and West Banks We have two options, in both we will enjoy the beech forests that we have at the foot of Balgerri: * We will continue along the track to the exit of the ravine and climb up the orographic right to the elevation 800. * Another option is to go up the Portillo de Brena and go around the Balgerri to the IIsos, pass through the pass and go down the riverbed.


