Simple ravine that is usually used as a return from Pallas and Cerrigüelo. Open in its first part and narrow and sinuous in the final part, really it could be skill all in opposition.

**Hydrology:**

**Access:** (machine translated)

Take the highway from Huesca to Barbastro at exit 77 towards Abiego/Alquézar. At Abiego turn towards Adahuesca and from there to Alquezar.

On the Barbastro side, take the A1232 up the Vero River to Alquezar.

When you arrive at the Alquezar car park, take a track on the left that goes up to San Pelegrín. We pass the abandoned village and continue straight on for about 2kms until we find the track that goes left and down to the Ermita de la Viña. Depending on the state of the track and the vehicle, we will see how far we can go. At 3.5 kms from the turnoff we will have to park, from here our path comes out.

If we want to descend the narrows we will need a combination of cars and we will leave it at the bridge of Alberuela.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Access to Bcos Pallas, Cerrigüelo and Viña

We will go down to the Ermita de la Viña, from here a path to the right will go through the vegetation to go down to the generally dry riverbed of the ravine.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

The first part is open and uninteresting to approach the final straits. Here we will have several rappels of up to 4m.

**Return:** (machine translated)

When we reach the Balcez we can continue doing the straits.

Or go up the Viña ravine in search of the Ermita.
