Summary: (machine translated) Simple (initiation) and little frequented canyon. It is a narrow gorge full of ledges, slides and small waterfalls to rappel. Without any difficulty except after heavy rains because its narrows can give problems.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Possible on a large part of the route		
Access: (machine translated) We can go from Puente de la Reina or from Huesca on the A132 and at km. 14 we will take the detour to Bolea. Upon reaching the village we enter and go around it until we find the GR and detour north to San Cristobal and the Ermita de Sta Quiteria. We will park in the vicinity		
Approach: (machine translated) We will leave by the well indicated PR to the Ermita de San Cristobal, once there we will change and go to the river.		
Tour: (machine translated) Initiation, very simple, with only 3 rappels. You can do some more by continuing a little further down the canyon but it is not worth it.		
Return: (machine translated) After the third rappel we will find a stream / ravine on the right and a pipe with a water catchment, at the point where the pipe leaves the bed there is a steep path on the left that soon leads us to the access path.
