<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Llisat or Barbarica really belongs to Sahún but with access by car through the forest track of Chía in the direction of Plan. The access and the return are short and simple. It is an unfrequented descent, short but technical and with abundant flow. It has two parts, the first of open character in which there are two waterfalls. After a small open stretch the riverbed narrows and forms a gorge where the most interesting part of the descent is found. With a succession of waterfalls that force to descend by the main vein. The spectacular part of the descent is in the last big waterfall. It is accessed by a handrail and a small rapel to the meeting of the long rapel.

<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) We must approach Chia; to do this we go by the N260 to Castejón de Sos and take the A139, towards Benasque, 100 m we have the detour to Chia. We cross the village and continue along the forest track to the Sahún pass, where we must leave the car.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Formerly you could go down by car to the hut des Prats; today, although the track is in very good condition, a sign of restricted access to authorized vehicles requires you to park at the pass of Sahún and walk the 3 km from here to the ravine. In the same way, the return also lengthens so you have to count on an hour of approach and about an hour and a quarter of return. After the last waterfall an obvious path goes off to the right through the forest. We follow it until we get to the track by which we have made the approach. Be careful on hot days as there is no shade during the approach and return, only at the beginning once we have left the riverbed.

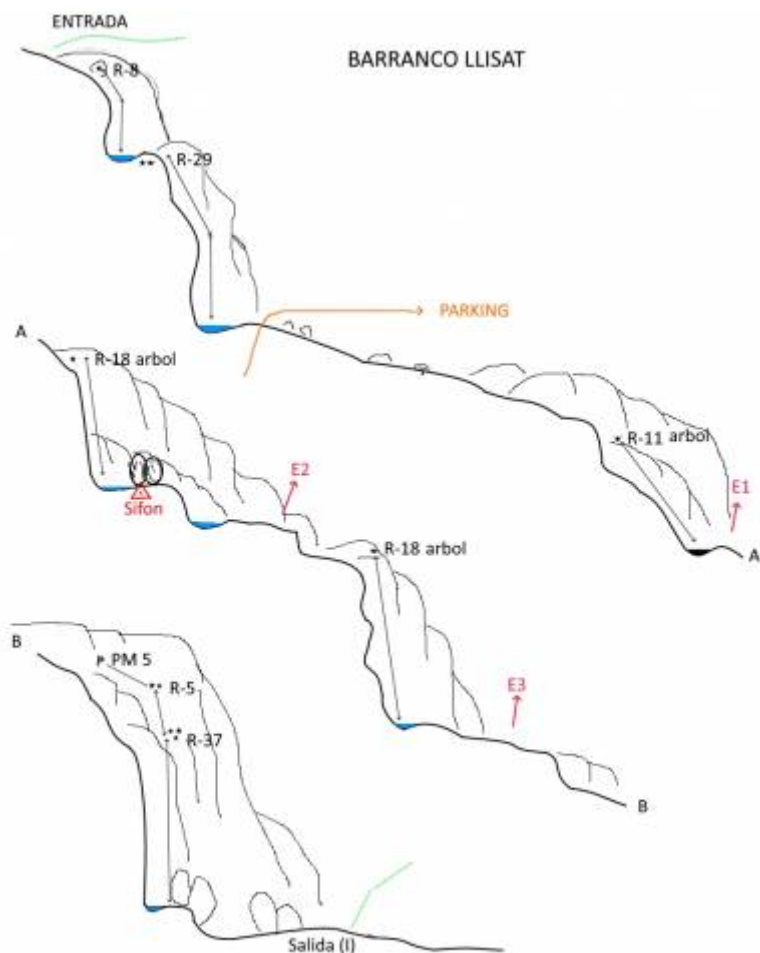
